COMPLETED TERMS

• cavity: space in a wall assembly

• **cladding:** non-load bearing wall element, inclusive of any coating and/or finish, serving as the outer layer, that is unprotected from exterior environmental conditions.

 drainage cavity: space in an enclosure wall assembly between the cladding and the water resistive barrier_that provides a passive means of directing liquid water to the exterior

• **exterior cavity:** space in an enclosure wall assembly between the cladding and the backup wall

• **non-load bearing wall element:** material or system that transfers load to the structure, does not contribute to overall structural performance of the wall and resists its own weight as well as loads imposed by surfaced mounted accessories that are allowed by design.

COMPLETED TERMS

• **rainscreen:** assembly applied to an exterior wall which consists of, at minimum, an outer layer, an inner layer, and a cavity between them sufficient for the passive removal of liquid water and water vapor

• **rainscreen cavity:** space in an enclosure wall assembly between the cladding and the water resistive barrier that provides a passive means of directing liquid water to the exterior and sufficient airflow to remove water vapor

• rainscreen cladding: cladding that is the water shedding outer layer of a rainscreen assembly.

• water control layer: the continuous layer comprised of one or more materials that resist the passage of liquid water





Installation Guide:

• Work: Stage 1 developing a set of common and standardized architectural details to guide proper installation methods and standardize approaches

Codes:

- Work: with Priest & Associates, development of a white paper explaining the impact of fire code standard NFPA 285 on Type V (Residential) construction
- Goal: White Paper by credible 3rd Party experts to aid in common understanding by members and the design/construction community of when and how important fire codes apply, when compliance may or may not be required, and how compliance may be achieved.

• Recruitment:

- Work: reach out to other companies involved in residential rainscreens, inform them of the work we are doing and how it might benefit them to participate
- Goal: broaden industry participation, ideally to include manufacturers not yet aware/involved and, importantly members from the contractor and design communities to broaden the experience and viewpoints of the Committee
